Creating an attachment limit configuration for a project

By default, a Jira Project has an attachment size limit that is defined as per global instance configuration (https://c onfluence.atlassian.com/x/MgISCw) but it cannot be specialized for a project. Herzum Attachment Manager app allows to configure a limit, by project, on the

number and on the max size for the files that may be attached to an issue.

You can easily setup the number and the max size of files that may be attached to an issue. by performing the following steps:
